First place Beginner/Intermediate Pageant winners are eligible to enter the Official Beginner/Intermediate National Pageants in July, 2026.**

OPEN Tot Division for ages 0-4 (All participants will receive an award)



ORDER OF APPEARANCE

AWR Pageant Modeling will begin with the Letter "S" then moved down 1/3 of the division for strut and twirl. All other events will be randomly sorted by the computer program. Open events will be scheduled before Regional or Pageant events when possible.



EVENT INFORMATION PER NBTA RULES

- **All West Regional (AWR) and Pageant** events are open to residents of the Western Region including AZ, CA, HI, NV, OR, UT, and WA. Athletes may enter one status level per event; Basic Skills Competition (BSC) athletes may also enter the Beginner Pageant.
- **Advanced Regional Divisions:** Regional Advanced athletes entering individual disciplines of Advanced X-Strut, Advanced Solo, and Advanced multiple baton championship events will have two judges and no preliminary round of competition.
- **All West Regional Pageant (Advanced)** will have two judges, each for Model, X-Strut and Twirl.
- **Basic Skills Competition:** This pageant event is open to Novice contestants only. Twirl status determines eligibility. 20% Modeling (circle T pattern without interview), 40% Basic Strut and 40% Twirl. (Attire per NBTA rules)
- **Open All West Model Queen:** All Levels; Model/Interview in costume, short or long dress; Open to all contestants in/out of region. *UNIQUE AWARDS!*
- **Visitor events** are open to all that do not reside in the All West Region.
- **Double entering** is permitted in Open and Visitor Events only.
- **Open All West “Battle-For-The-Golden-Boot”** – A two part event featuring Solo Twirl and 2-Baton, All-levels, per age division, 0-6,7-9,10-12,13-15,16+; Open to all competitors in/out of region. *UNIQUE AWARDS!*
- **Miss Twirling Cowgirl Open Pageant** – Open to all competitors in/out of region; Contest is 20% Modeling w/ Interview (Novice – Model/No interview), 40% X-Strut (Novice - Basic Strut) and 40% Twirl. (Attire per NBTA rules) *UNIQUE AWARDS!*
- **One Hour clinic** will take place before the final awards ceremony on Sunday and will be taught by World-Class Coaches.
- **Status Levels:** A win in a higher class automatically advances the athlete to that class.
 - **1st Time Solo** – A contestant who is competing for the first time.
 - **Special Novice Class** – A contestant that has never won a Novice Solo first-place.
 - **Novice Class** – A contestant is a novice until receiving five first-place novice wins in a contest category. She or he then advances to the Beginner class.
 - **Beginner Class** – A contestant is a beginner until receiving five first-place Beginner wins in a contest category, or a 1st place in a higher division. She or he then advances to the Intermediate class/ higher division. *PAGEANT:* A twirler is limited to two Beginner State and/or Regional pageant wins. (Due to covid lockdowns, pageant wins between August 2019 and July 2020 will not be counted. The number of 0-6 Beginner pageant wins is unlimited.)
 - **Intermediate Class** – A contestant is an intermediate until receiving eight first-place Intermediate wins in a contest category. She or he then graduates to the elite Advanced class. *PAGEANT:* A twirler is limited to two Intermediate State and/or Regional pageant wins. (Due to covid lockdowns, pageant wins between August 2019 and July 2020 will not be counted. The number of 0-6 Intermediate pageant wins is unlimited.)
 - **Advanced Class** – A contestant has reached the highest and most prestigious competitive level.
 - **AWR Collegiate Pageant** – Per NBTA rules, “shall compete in twirling contest by using a 2:20 – 2:30 show routine. The first half with one baton. The second half of routine may, if desired, incorporate other twirling media, except fire, to standard music. Entrants are those who are furthering her education by attending a College, University or other Institutions of higher learning.”
- **Pageant Judging** – 20% Model, 40% X-Strut, 40% Twirl; Ties will be broken by twirling score.
- **NBTA Rules Apply** – Visit nbtainternational.com (Rules and Scoresheets); Knowledge of the rules is the direct responsibility of each contestant.
- **A 2.0 penalty** will be assessed for competing out of order, as per NBTA Rules.
- **Contestants MUST BE in costume for all award ceremonies.**
- **NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY ALLOWED!** Videotaping is allowed only of own child or student.
